PARTNERSHIP COORDINATOR

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Profile: Ability to identify, develop, and maintain a network of strategic partners (NGOs, universities, businesses). Communication skills. Organizational skills, autonomy, and attention to detail in tracking commitments.

Main Tasks:

Developing and Managing Partnerships:

- Identify NGOs with shared objectives to engage in joint actions.
- Develop relationships with universities to create and maintain connections with students and researchers interested in our initiatives.
- Establish collaborations with companies invested in environmental protection, aligned with our values.
- Ensure ongoing engagement with existing partners.
- Analyze the effectiveness of partnerships and suggest improvements to strengthen collaboration.

Representation and Negotiation:

- Attend events, conferences, and strategic meetings to represent the organization and expand our network.
- Negotiate and formalize partnership agreements, defining mutual commitments.
- Collaborate with internal teams to maximize the impact of partnerships on our projects.

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AMBASSADORS PROGRAM CO-COORDINATOR

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Desired Profile: Ability to motivate and unite a network of committed volunteers. Strong organizational and management skills to oversee a program with dozens of ambassadors worldwide. Comfortable managing online communities (WhatsApp, social media). Initiative and autonomy to coordinate the program efficiently.

Main Tasks:

Coordinating and Managing the Ambassadors Program:

- Ensure the program runs smoothly and oversee its development.
- Assist in selecting candidates whose profiles align with the organization's mission and values.
- Welcome and integrate new ambassadors by providing necessary resources.
- Manage WhatsApp groups and other communication tools to facilitate exchanges and maintain engagement.
- Organize meetings and training sessions to support and guide ambassadors in their initiatives.

Community Engagement:

- Maintain regular contact with ambassadors to encourage and guide their projects.
- Create and share inspiring content to energize the community.
- Highlight ambassadors' initiatives by showcasing their work.
- Identify challenges faced by ambassadors and help find solutions.

Program Development and Improvement:

Note: Two co-coordinators are responsible for organizing the program, one of whom has been involved for several years, ensuring continuity and mutual support in managing the ambassadors. Additionally, regional coordinators, assigned by region and country, provide valuable assistance, facilitating communication and support for ambassadors.

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FUNDRAISING COORDINATOR

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Profile: Experience in writing grant proposals and fundraising, ideally in the non-profit sector or in corporate partnership management. Comfortable with public speaking to represent the coalition and capable of developing and maintaining a network of financial partners. Strong communication and negotiation skills. Organized, detail-oriented, and able to work independently.

Main Responsibilities:

Private and Public Fundraising:

- Develop, implement, and oversee an annual strategic fundraising plan to ensure sustainable financing for the association's activities.
- Identify new funding opportunities, including partnerships with companies and public/private institutions aligned with our mission.
- Draft grant proposals and funding applications.

Donor and Partner Relationship Management:

- Manage partnerships and build donor loyalty through targeted communication and appreciation initiatives.
- Conduct outreach campaigns to attract new donors.

Fundraising Campaign Coordination:

- Supervise donation appeals and digital fundraising initiatives.
- Collaborate with the communication team to ensure visibility of the association's activities to potential donors.
- Monitor budgets and provide financial reporting.

Status: Volunteer. A few hours per week, with flexible scheduling.

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JURISTS PROGRAM CO-COORDINATOR

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Profile: Law background with experience in managing and drafting legal projects. Strong organizational skills and attention to detail. In-depth knowledge of environmental law, particularly international environmental law and constitutional environmental law. Excellent legal writing skills in both French and English. Ability to coordinate remote teams and manage projects effectively.

Main Responsibilities:

Program Coordination:

- Develop and manage an international program that brings together legal experts from diverse backgrounds to produce impactful written contributions.
- Mobilize legal professionals worldwide to actively participate in the association's initiatives.
- Maintain a network of environmental law specialists, focusing on fundamental rights and general principles of environmental law.
- Organize and lead collaborative working sessions to discuss key issues and priorities.

Legal Contributions:

- Identify legal advocacy opportunities and track relevant calls for contributions (from international bodies, courts, public institutions).
- Coordinate legal teams to respond effectively to calls for contributions within deadlines.
- Oversee the drafting of strategic legal documents such as **amicus curiae** briefs and policy recommendations.

VOLUNTEER POSITION

Profile: Legal background with skills in communication or educational project management. Experience in creating and managing educational content. Passion for education and environmental protection.

Main Responsibilities:

Development of Online Educational Content:

- Expand and structure the educational section of the website with engaging, pedagogical content tailored to various audiences.
- Identify educational needs and develop relevant programs accordingly.
- Collaborate with internal teams and external experts to create high-quality content (articles, videos, podcasts, guides, etc.).

Webinars & Training Sessions:

- Plan and organize regular webinars on topics related to the association's mission.
- Manage event logistics, including coordination with speakers and participant communication.

Educational Resources Creation:

- Develop digital educational materials (videos, PDFs, infographics, and other accessible tools for the website and social media).

Promotion & Outreach:

- Work with the communication team to promote educational content through newsletters and social media.
- Establish partnerships with educational institutions and academic experts.

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LEGAL MONITORING AND LEGAL CONTENT COORDINATOR VOLUNTEER

Profile: Legal background with a strong interest in making legal information accessible. Strong ability to synthesize and analyze legal news. Good writing skills in French and/or English. Interest in environmental issues.

Main responsibilities: Ensure structured and actionable legal monitoring for the Coalition, and transform this monitoring into clear and useful content for internal teams as well as external communications (particularly LinkedIn and newsletters). The coordinator's objective is to better inform the organization about regulatory and case law developments, support the communication strategy, and strengthen the Coalition's ability to position itself and adapt its actions.

Legal monitoring and analysis:

- Identify and track legislative, regulatory, and case law developments relevant to the organization's activities.
- Summarize legal information in an accessible and practical way.
- Produce regular monitoring briefs with critical analysis of key issues and concrete impacts for the organization and its partners.
- Set up an effective monitoring system (sources, frequency, tools).

Support for communication strategy:

- Collaborate with the communications team to integrate legal monitoring insights into the organization's editorial line.
- Identify relevant legal topics to highlight in external communications.
- Help strengthen the organization's credibility and legitimacy on regulatory and institutional matters.
